INFORMATION ABOUT OUR USE OF COOKIES

www.Jamo.com uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website as set forth in this Cookie Policy (except with respect to the Jamo Checkout pages, which maintains its own separate Cookie Policy). This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site. By continuing to browse the site, you are agreeing to our use of cookies.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.

We use the following cookies:

- **Strictly necessary cookies.** These are cookies that are required for the operation of our website. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our website, use a shopping cart or make use of e-billing services.
- **Analytical/performance cookies.** They allow us to recognize and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.
- **Functionality cookies.** These are used to recognize you when you return to our website. This enables us to personalize our content for you, greet you by name and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region).
- **Targeting cookies.** These cookies record your visit to our website, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed. We will use this information to make our website and the advertising displayed on it more relevant to your interests. We may also share this information with third parties for this purpose.

You can find more information about the individual cookies we use and the purposes for which we use them in the table below:

Craft CMS Session Unique Identifier Code	CraftSessionId	Used as a randomly-generated unique identifier for the visitor's browsing session, not directly tied to any other information. This is set by Craft CMS (the backend for Jamo.com)	First-party cookie; Expires after browser is closed.
Craft CMS CSRF-prevention token	CRAFT_CSRF_TOKEN	Randomly-generated string to assist in prevention of Cross-Site Request Forgery attacks (CSRF). No user PII information is associated with this.	First-party cookie; Expires after browser is closed.

Jamo Visitor Geolocation IP Address	Jamo_Visitor	This cookie stores the user's IP address (if the user has Javascript enabled and the user's IP address is public). This is stored to prevent subsequent GeoLocation Service lookups. We use this IP address to determine what country the user is located in, in order to display or hide ecommerce functionality on the site, or to show or hide certain other content that is relevant to the user's country.	First-party cookie; Expires in 30 days
Google Analytics Client ID	_ga	In order for Google Analytics to determine that two distinct hits belong to the same user, a unique identifier, associated with that particular user, must be sent with each hit. The analytics.js library accomplishes this via the Client ID field, a unique, randomly generated string that gets stored in the browsers cookies, so subsequent visits to the same site can be associated with the same user.	First-party cookie; Expires in 2 years
Google Analytics GID	_gid	Used by Google Analytics to distinguish users, similarly to the "_ga" cookie, is a unique, randomly-generated string.	First-party cookie; Expires in 24 hours
Kibo Shopping Cart ID	Shopatron_cart_id_{Cart_ID}	Randomly-generated, unique string to identify a user's shopping cart on Klipsch.com and checkout.klipsch.com – not tied to any user's PII.	First-party cookie; Expires in 30 days
Google Ads /	IDE	These cookies are used to deliver adverts more	Third-party cookie; more info at: https://policies.google.com/technologies/types

Except for essential cookies, and third party cookies that we do not control, cookies expire as listed in the above chart.
